

Widow Found Dead at Her Home in the Fairmont District

**Mrs. Edith Cummings, 52 Died
From Heart Trouble**

Mrs. Edith Cummings, aged 52, was found dead last Saturday evening at her home one mile south of Fairmont. Pete Anderson, an occasional boarder at her home, found her and reported it to Dr. Byrne. Her body was taken to Mumaw's Funeral Home at Lancaster for autopsy conducted Tuesday, at which it was determined that death was caused by heart failure.

Mrs. Cummings had lived alone at her ranch at Fairmont. She had apparently started to prepare her evening meal before death came. Her sister, Mrs. Ethel Harrington, reported that she had not seen Mrs. Cummings for about three weeks.

Mrs. Cummings was born in Manning, Iowa, had lived in California about sixteen years and at her present ranch home two. A brother and his wife arrived Monday evening from Salt Lake City to attend the services.

Funeral services are being held today at the Episcopal Church in Lancaster, conducted by the Rev. Boyd Parker.
