

Helen Steengrafe services held

Funeral services for Helen I. Steengrafe, a 74-year-old former Lancaster homemaker who died Jan. 1 at Saddleback Community Hospital, Laguna Hills, were held yesterday morning at Mumaw Funeral Home.

Interment was at Lancaster Cemetery, with Elder Vernon Shirk, Reorganized Church of Latter Day Saints, officiating.

Mrs. Steengrafe, who lived at Laguna Hills, had been a Lancaster resident from 1947 until 1964 when she moved to Orange County.

Death was due to a stroke climaxing a five-year illness.

Mrs. Steengrafe, born Oct. 9, 1900, in Nevada, Mo., had been a California resident since 1910.

She is survived by her husband, Roy, whom she married in San Francisco in September 1935.
